## ORDER DENYING REHEARING OF DECISION NO. 91495

A document entitled "PETITION OF TELEPHONE ANSWERING SERVICES, INC., FOR REHEARING AND RECONSIDERATION OF DECISION NUMBER 91495," was filed on August 6, 1980.

The petitioner was not a party to these proceedings. It is thus precluded from filing for rehearing by Section 1731 of the Public Utilities Code.
