ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 89549 in Application 58188, we authorized a transfer of certain passenger stage operating rights to C T & E Travel Corporation. Said transference was completed and the transferee accepted the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as authorized by Decision 89549. However, tariff and timetable filings, as required by our order in that decision, were not made. Accordingly, the Commission staff contacted C T & E Travel Corporation and was advised that it would soon make the necessary filings and wished to inaugurate service with the start of the spring 1979 travel season. Contemporaneously, C T & E applied for additional passenger stage operating authority, which we granted by Decision 89891 on January 16, 1979 (Application 58402). It was, thereafter, expected that C T & E would make the requisite tariff, timetable, and insurance filings for all of its passenger stage routes, as extended by Decision 89891, and that these filings would be made prior to the summer travel season in 1979. These filings were not forthcoming,

however, and, by letter dated August 2, 1979, the staff requested the applicant to explain its intention regarding these passenger stage services.

By letter dated August 14, 1979, Ruth Margolies, President *KA* of C T & E Travel Corporation, stated applicant's intention to be fully operational no later than the summer travel season of 1980. Thereafter, by Decision 90913, we ordered that applicant be granted an extension of time to June 1, 1980 to complete the tariff, timetable, and insurance filing requirements of Decisions 89549 and 89891, and until June 15, 1980 to commence operations. It is now past these dates. No tariff, timetable or insurance filings have been received and service has accordingly not commenced.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked. Since <sup>there</sup> ~~there~~ is no insurance on file, *order should be effective on* the ~~effective date should be~~ the date hereof. *KA* ✓

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation authorized by Decisions 89549 and 89891 is hereby revoked upon the effective date of this order.
