## ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By this application Harbor Carriers, Inc. (Harbor) seeks a further extension of time in which to inaugurate passenger service by vessel between San Francisco and Sausalito. In Decision No. 90725 dated August 28, 1979 we granted an extension of time to September 28, 1980. A protest to the present application was filed by the Marin-Sonoma Commuters Committee.

A public hearing was held on September 11, 1980 in San Francisco before Administrative Law Judge Bernard A. Peeters. Because the hearing was not completed on September 11, it was continued to November 24, 1980.

Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 79143 which granted the authority to serve Sausalito reads as follows:

"3. Application No. 52409 is granted for a one-year period from the effective date hereof, and if the common carrier passenger service by vessel between San Francisco and Sausalito [which] Harbor Carriers, Inc., has heretofore been authorized to provide by Decision No. 73811, dated March 5, 1968, in Application No. 49712, is not commenced within said period, said authority shall lapse and terminate unless the one-year period is extended by further order of the Commission."

Since the certificate will lapse and terminate on September 28, 1980 during the pendency of hearings on this matter without a further order of the Commission,

IT IS ORDERED that the period of time in which to inaugurate service between San Francisco and Sausalito is extended to the date that a decision in this matter is issued and has become final.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
