ORDER GRANTING
REHEARING OF DECISION
NO. 91972

An application for rehearing of Decision No. 91972 has been filed by the Warmington Group (Warmington), a protestant in this proceeding. The applicant has filed a response, asking that rehearing be denied. Decision No. 91972 was an interim opinion in which all determinations were made subject to further study and hearing. We fully expect that the allegations of error in Warmington's application will be issues upon which evidence and argument will be heard at these further hearings. However, to be sure that all parties understand that no issues have been conclusively determined by Decision No. 91972, we will grant rehearing and consolidate that rehearing with the further hearings already anticipated.

We further remind the applicant in this proceeding that it has the burden of showing what, if any, increase should be authorized in its CIA-BP charges. It is not incumbent upon the customers to show the contrary. Good cause appearing,
