ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 59890, as amended, Peerless Stages, Inc. (Peerless) was granted authority as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-21) to transport passengers, baggage and express between certain points in the Counties of Alameda, Santa Clara and Santa Cruz.

By Decision No. 90682 dated August 14, 1979, in Application No. 58840, Peerless was granted additional authority to transport passengers between the Cities of Oakland, San Francisco, Daly City, San Jose, Fremont, Berkeley, El Cerrito, Richmond, San Leandro, Hayward, Santa Clara and Palo Alto, California, on the one hand, and performances at the Circle Star Theater, San Carlos, California, on the other hand.

Resolution No. PE-378 dated May 6, 1980 restated Peerless' certificate of public convenience and necessity (Appendix A).

Ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 90682 required applicant to comply with certain service regulations of the Commission's General Order 98-Series and establish the authorized service within 120 days after the effective date of the order. Peerless has not complied with any of these service regulations. Upon being queried by the Commission staff, Peerless states in its letter of August 13, 1980, that because of the energy crisis it has decided

against going ahead with the authorized service. The Commission staff recommends therefore that the authority granted by Decision No. 90682 be revoked.

It appears and the Commission finds that this matter constitutes good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision No. 90682 is hereby revoked upon the effective date of this order.

2. Third Revised Page 10 of Appendix A of Resolution No. PE-378 dated May 6, 1980 is hereby cancelled.




