ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND  
MODIFYING DECISION NO. 92064

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 92064. Tuolumne County Water District No. 2 (TCWD#2) has filed a petition for modification in which it asks that PG&E's petition be denied.

We have carefully considered each and every allegation of error and recommendation for modifying Decision No. 92064 and are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown. However, certain ordering paragraphs should be modified to make our intentions even more clear. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 5 of Decision No. 92064 shall be modified to read in full as follows:

3. Upon Commission approval of the plans filed in conformance to Ordering Paragraph 2, PG&E shall expeditiously undertake and initiate construction of the facilities required.

5. PG&E's plans for piping the existing ditch system shall be submitted to the California Department of Fish and Game for its review and consultation regarding a water supply for wildlife at elevations less than 3,000 feet above sea level.

2. Rehearing of Decision No. 92064 as modified above is denied.

The effective date of this order and of Decision No. 92064 as modified shall be the date hereof.
