ORDER CORRECTING DECISION NO. 92251

Through clerical error several sentences were unclear in Decision No. 92251, dated September 16, 1980, in OII No. 42. A review of the affected pages indicates that these errors should be corrected.

Pursuant to Resolution No. A-4661,
IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. On page 34, third sentence of first unnumbered paragraph should read:


We have also kept in mind that utility loans will not be available for retrofits of electric water heaters, multi-family gas water heaters, or 50% of single family gas water heaters or for direct sales by contractors.

2. On page 48, last sentence of fourth paragraph should read: Since the minimum standards to be utilized in this demonstration program are not in codes nor intended to become code, building inspectors would have no training to conduct the inspections.

3. On page 51, last sentence of last paragraph should read: If the inspection is waived, final payment shall be made within 48 hours after notice of waiver has been issued.
