ORDER OF REVOCATION

Commission Decision No. 91218, dated January 8, 1980, granted Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Willie L. Anderson, Sr., and Sammy E. Bogan, Sr., a partnership, doing business as A and B Bus Service, to operate as a passenger stage Corporation, PSC 1100, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, transporting home-to-work passengers between various points in Oakland, Hayward, San Jose, on the one hand, and the General Motor Corporations Assembly Division (G.M.A.D.) Plant in Fremont, on the other hand.

Ordering paragraph 2 of the decision required applicant to comply with the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101-Series, and file tariffs and timetables by May 28, 1980.

On January 18, 1980, the Commission staff sent a letter to W. Anderson, President of A and B Bus Service, requesting him to file a written acceptance of the certificate not later than March 9, 1980, and a tariff <sup>and</sup> timetable and a certificate of insurance not later than May 28, 1980. The letter cautioned him of paragraph 2 of the order which states "failure to do so may result in a cancellation of the authority." SS

By a letter dated June 18, 1980, the Commission staff informed Mr. Anderson that he had not responded to the letter of January 18, 1980, nor had he filed the required tariff and timetable, and that his insurance had expired on June 15, 1980. Mr. Anderson was informed that unless he complied with all the filing requirements by July 15, 1980, the staff would recommend that the Commission revoke his passenger stage authority.

The applicant has not responded to either letter nor has he filed his tariff, timetable, or insurance as of this date.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision 91218 is hereby revoked upon the effective date of this order.
