O P I N I O N

Applicant Jean Isola Humes requests the issuance of a dump truck carrier permit. At the time of filing this application, applicant held no other operating authority from this Commission. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of September 22, 1980. No protest to the application has been received.

Applicant's place of business is at 1250 Leighton Avenue, Los Angeles, California. Applicant operates one end dump truck and proposes to haul asphalt, dirt, sand, and gravel in the Los Angeles area. As of September 10, 1980 applicant's balance sheet indicates a net worth of \$107,000. The application was supported by the California Department of Transportation.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant is a fit and proper person to receive a permit as a dump truck carrier and possesses sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to perform the proposed operation.
2. Applicant's equipment will not endanger the safety of highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.

3. Applicant's proposed operation will not unnecessarily burden the public highways, is necessary to serve the public, and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

4. Applicant has resided in the State of California for not less than ninety days immediately preceding the filing of this application.

5. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusion of Law

The Commission concludes that applicant should be granted a dump truck permit authorizing operation within a 100-mile radius of the city of Los Angeles. *The effective date should be the date of issuance to be consistent with the issuance of permits to other classes of carriers.*
ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that upon applicant's compliance with the Commission's General Order No. 100-H, the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Jean Isola Humes authorizing operations within a 100-mile radius of the city of Los Angeles.

The effective date of this order shall be ~~thirty days after~~ *is* the date hereof.
