ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This complaint was filed concerning, inter alia, certain alleged unlawful passenger stage movements of Sanae Travel International (Sanae).

Prior to the filing of the complaint, Sanae had already filed Application No. 58943 which requested a certificate for certain passenger stage service.

Hearings were held on the application on November 8, 1979 and on March 20 and 21, 1980. The Commission issued Decision No. 92083 on July 29, 1980 denying certification and ordering Sanae to cease and desist from illegal transportation movements.

On September 10, 1980 Administrative Law Judge Meaney, assigned to both proceedings, wrote to the complainant asking if, in view of the result in the application matter, it would be necessary to proceed with the complaint.

On September 15, 1980, Richard J. Lee, attorney representing complainant, answered by letter, indicating that the complaint could be dismissed.

Accordingly, we find and conclude that we may dismiss Case No. 10803.
