OPINION AND ORDER

By this application: Frank L. Moore, General Partner, and Kathleen L. Moore, Marilyn L. Moore, Jennifer E. Moore, Frank L. Moore, Jr., Thomas E. Moore and James T. Hitchcock, Limited Partners, dba Truck Investment Company; and Jerre R. Moore, General Partner, and Michael J. Moore, Timothy L. Moore, Terrence D. Moore and Dee Ann M. Moore, Limited Partners, dba Best Way Investments; doing business as Moore Truck Lines, seek authority to cancel their participation in tariffs issued by James F. Hauser, Tariff Publishing Officer, Pacific Coast Tariff Bureau, Agent (PCTB) and transfer their participation into various tariffs of Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent (WMTB).

Applicants have determined that it would be in their best interests to transfer from issues of PCTB to issues of WMTB. Applicants have also determined that a number of advantages would accrue to themselves as a result of the proposed transfer. Due to inherent differences between tariffs issued by PCTB and tariffs issued by WMTB, rate increases would result from the proposed transfer.

Applicants state that the granting of this application would result in an increase of approximately \$2,000 per year and would not increase their California intrastate gross revenue by as much as one percent. The increase is within the President's wage-price guidelines.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of September 23, 1980. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicants' proposal is reasonable and justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.
