ORDER OF INVESTIGATION AND SUSPENSION

By petition filed October 7, 1980, Sward Trucking, Inc., seeks investigation and suspension of Rate Reduction 74 filed by Cal-Trails, Inc., to transport at reduced rates shipments of lumber and forest products for Louisiana-Pacific Corporation. The rates apply from Oroville, Rocklin and Ukiah to the Los Angeles Basin area and were to become effective October 18, 1980.

By order dated October 17, 1980, the Executive Director assigned (I&S) Case No. 10917 to this matter and by reason of his authority under Resolution M-4713 suspended the rates contained in Rate Reduction 74 before the rates went into effect. We hereby affirm the actions of the Executive Director.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The contract provisions in Rate Reduction 74 of Cal-Trails, Inc., to become effective October 19, 1980 are hereby suspended and the use thereof deferred until further order of the Commission.

2. A public hearing on this matter shall be held before such Commissioner or Administrative Law Judge as may be designated, at a time and place to be determined.




