ORDER STAYING DECISION NO. 92236

Toward Utility Rate Normalization (TURN) has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 92236 in these proceedings. That decision denied TURN's petition for award of attorney fees and other costs after finding and concluding that the rules established in Decision No. 91909 for awarding such fees and costs should not be applied retroactively.


At this time Decision No. 91909 is still subject to administrative and judicial review. Petitions for rehearing, filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company and by Southern California Edison Company, are still being considered. The rules in question, therefore, are clearly subject to change and Decision No. 91909 is not final.

Under these circumstances we conclude that Decision No. 92236 should be stayed so that we may consider the merits of TURN's petition when the validity of the rules in question has been settled. Therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 92236 is stayed until further order of this Commission.


