<u>OPINION</u>

Applicant Montcliff Trucking Co., a California corporation, requests the issuance of a dump truck carrier permit. At the time of filing this application, applicant held no operating authority from the Commission. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of September 5. 1980. No protest to the application has been received.

Applicant's place of business is 7109 S. Alameda Street, Los Angeles, California. Applicant operates 4 tractors, 4 vans, and one dolly. He proposes to haul dirt, rock, sand, and gravel in Los Angeles, Riverside, Orange, and San Bernardino counties. As of April 30, 1980, applicant's balance sheet indicates total assets of \$94,591.55. The application is supported by the City of Los Angeles and Livingston-Graham of Irwindale, California. Findings of Fact

- 1. Applicant is a fit and proper entity to receive a permit as a dump truck carrier. Its officers possess sufficient operating knowledge and it has the financial ability to perform the proposed operation.
- 2. Applicant's equipment will not endanger the safety of highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.

- 3. Applicant's proposed operation will not unnecessarily burden the public highways, is necessary to serve the public, and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.
- 4. Applicant is a domestic corporation qualified to transact business in the State of California at the time of the filing of this application.
- 5. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusion of Law

The Commission concludes that applicant should be granted a dump truck permit authorizing operation within Los Angeles, Riverside, Orange, and San Bernardino counties.

OKDER

IT IS ORDERED that upon applicant's compliance with the Commission's General Order No. 100-H, the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Montcliff Trucking Company, a California corporation, authorizing operations within Los Angeles, Riverside, Orange, and San Bernardino counties.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
