ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 91952 dated June 17, 1980 ordered Samuel H. Stanley and Robert Ross (partnership), doing business as Sad Sam's Trucking, to collect \$8,011.21, and Samuel H. Stanley (Stanley) to collect \$11,661.27 from respondent Newhall Refining Company, Inc. and to pay said amounts as fines on or before August 29, 1980. The partnership and Stanley were also ordered to pay punitive fines in the amount of \$2,500 each, which payment was due on or before August 29, 1980.

By this petition (letter dated October 14, 1980) it is requested: (1) that the payment of each fine in paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision No. 91952 be stayed for a period of four months and then be paid at the rate of \$1,000 per month until the fines shall be paid in full; (2) that the payment of the fines in paragraphs 3 and 4 of Decision No. 91952 be stayed until the action in Stanley v Newhall Refining Company, Inc., et al., C334836 filed October 3, 1980, in the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Los Angeles, can be heard and judgment entered thereon provided that Stanley or his attorney make regular reports on the status of the case as required by Decision No. 91952.

By memorandum dated October 22, 1980, the Transportation Division advises that it has no objection to an extension of time for the payment of the fines. We find that Stanley's request is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision No. 91952 are modified to provide that the ^{fine} ~~times~~ specified therein shall be paid in five installments beginning January ¹² 1981 and on the first day of each succeeding month at the rate of \$1,000 per month.

2. Ordering paragraphs 3 and 4 of Decision No. 91952 are modified to provide that fines specified therein shall be paid in full within thirty days after the court's determination in the matter of Samuel H. Stanley v Newhall Refining Company, Inc., et al. C334836 ^{to} the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Los Angeles has become final.

3. In all other respects Decision No. 91952 shall remain in full force and effect.
