ORDER CONFIRMING TRANSFER OF CLASS A CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER OF PASSENGERS

On July 24, 1979, the Commission received an application to transfer a class A certificate to operate as a charter-party carrier of passengers from Serve-A-Car of Northern California (a corporation) to San Francisco-Yosemite Tours, Inc. (a corporation), File No. TCP-62-A. The transfer was authorized September 7, 1979 by Schedule No. 131 Charter-Party Action authorized by Resolution No. P.E. 303, approved July 29, 1975.

On September 21, 1979, a response and protest to the application to transfer was filed by Dolphin Tours, Inc. At that time the application was filed in the Docket Office and given Application No. 59153.

Subsequently on September 8, 1980, in response to a letter from Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Cline, Richard J. Lee, attorney, advised ALJ Cline as follows:

'We have been asked by J. Mark Lavelle of Dolphin Tours to reply to your letter of May 23, 1980.

'Dolphin Tours hereby withdraws its protest to the referenced application. [Application No. 59153, San Francisco-Yosemite Tours, Inc., File No. TCP-62-A]."

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The transfer of the Class A certificate to operate as a charter-party carrier of passengers from Serve-A-Car of Northern California to San Francisco-Yosemite Tours, Inc., pursuant to application to transfer certificate as a charter-party carrier of passengers filed July 24, 1979, as evidenced by Class A certificate to operate as a charter-party carrier of passengers issued on August 31, 1979, to San Francisco-Yosemite Tours, Inc., File No. TCP-62-A, and by Schedule No. 131 Charter-Party Action, dated September 7, 1979, authorized by Resolution No. P.E. 303 approved July 29, 1975, is hereby confirmed by the Commission.
- 2. The Commission also confirms the issuance to San Francisco-Yosemite Tours, Inc., of the annual renewable certificate dated August 31, 1979, on Form PE-694 by the Passenger Operations Branch under the authorization of Resolution PE-303, approved July 29, 1975.
