Wright in the Commission Courtroom, 107 South Broadway, Los Angeles, California, on February 25, 1981, at 10:00 a.m., if any cause there be why he should not be adjudged in contempt of the decision and order of this Commission made on May 20, 1980, in the above-entitled matters, to wit, Decision No. 91806, Ordering Paragraph No. 6.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Gerald Wedel further appear and show cause at the aforementioned time and place if any cause there be why the Commission should not punish for such contempt as it may find by fining Gerald Wedel as described in Public Utilities Code Sections 2107, 2108 and 2110 and/or by imprisonment of Gerald Wedel until said Gerald Wedel does or performs or causes to be done or performed the acts of installing a water storage tank with a capacity of at least 64,000 gallons to the facilities of the Pine Mountain Water Company.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Executive Director of this Commission cause a true copy of the Affidavit of Robert M. Mann attached hereto to be personally served upon Gerald Wedel with this order.

55	Robert M. Mann, being first duly sworn, deposes and			
23	says:			
24	That he is employed as a Senior Utilities Engineer by the			
25	Public Utilities Commission of the State of California			
26	(hereinafter, "Commission") with business address at 107 South			
27	Broadway, Los Angeles, California 90012.			

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That on May 20, 1980, the Commission issued Decision No. 91806 directing that Gerald Wedel, doing business as Pine Mountain 3 Co., install as part of the facilities of that water company, inter alia, a water storage tank with a capacity of at least 5 64,000 gallons as expeditiously as possible, but not later than ninety days after May 20, 1980, and, within five days after the 7 | new storage tank was placed in service, file a completion notice with the Commission. That on or about November 10, 1980, he personally made an on-site visual inspection of the facilities of the Pine Mountain Water Co. pursuant to his duties as an employee of the Commission.

That during said inspection, he did not see any evidence that a water storage tank had been installed as required by Decision No. 91806.

That he was accompanied on said inspection by Gerald Wedel 16 and a person who represented himself as being an employee of the 17 Pine Mountain Water Co., one Herman Kanthack.

That during said inspection both Gerald Wedel and Herman 19 Kanthack admitted to knowledge of Decision No. 91806 and its 20 requirements and to knowledge that the Pine Mountain Water Co. 21 |should comply with said decision.

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That during said inspection both Gerald Wedel and Herman Kanthack admitted that no water storage tank had been installed despite their knowledge of the requirements of Decision No. 91806.
