ORDER AMENDING INTERIM DECISION NO. 91968

Decision No. 91968 dated July 2, 1980, in the instant proceeding, ordered that the Commission would be bound in this proceeding by the California Energy Commission's (Energy Commission) Biennial Report, adopted December 20, 1979, as to forecast of electrical load and sales but not as to resource planning or need for the project to meet the forecasted demand.

It has come to our attention that on December 31, 1980 the Energy Commission adopted its most recent Biennial Report which supersedes the report adopted December 20, 1979.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the Commission will be bound in this proceeding by the California Energy Commission's Biennial Report, adopted December 31, 1980, rather than the Biennial Report, adopted December 20, 1979, as to forecast of electrical load and sales but not as to resource planning or need for the project to meet the forecasted demand.
