ORDER OF DENIAL

Gary Lee Stapp, an individual, doing business as Sacramento Van Lines, 8516A Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, CA 95826, has made application for a household goods carrier permit.

By letter dated November 12, 1980 sent to the above address, Gary Lee Stapp was requested to submit to the Commission a certified copy of the Fictitious Business Name Statement required by Chapter 5, Part 3 of Division 7 of the Business and Professions Code of California, filed with the County Clerk, and the affidavit of Publication issued by said County Clerk in connection therewith. Mr. Stapp was informed that if the requested documents were not received by November 24, 1980, his application would be denied.

On November 17, 1980 the letter addressed to Mr. Stapp was returned undelivered with the notation that the addressee had moved and left no forwarding address with the Sacramento Post Office. To date, no documents have been received from Mr. Stapp.

In view of the foregoing, the Commission finds that Gary Lee Stapp has not complied with valid directives of the Commission staff and concludes that his application should be denied. IT IS ORDERED that Application 59847 is denied.
