O P I N I O N

Jondel Trucking, Incorporated, a California corporation, requests the issuance of a dump truck carrier permit. Applicant currently possesses operating authority as a highway contract carrier. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of October 6, 1980. No protest to the application has been received.

Applicant's place of business is 2349 Three Bar Lane, Norco, California. Applicant operates one tractor and one set of trailers and proposes to haul dirt, sand, and gravel in the southern California area. As of August 30, 1980 applicant's balance sheet indicates a net worth of \$72,174 with cash on hand of \$10,774. The application was supported by All American Asphalt Co.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant is a fit and proper person to receive a permit as a dump truck carrier and possesses sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to perform the proposed operation.
2. Applicant's equipment will not endanger the safety of highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.
3. Applicant's proposed operation will not unnecessarily burden the public highways, is necessary to serve the public, and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

4. Applicant has resided in the State of California for not less than 90 days immediately preceding the filing of the application.

5. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operation within and between the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino.

2. The effective date should be the date of issuance to be consistent with the issuance of permits to other classes of carriers.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Jondel Trucking, Incorporated, authorizing operations within and between the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino.
