ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainant previously filed informal complaint No. 792-1819-T concerning a billing dispute and deposited the disputed amount of \$233.10 with the Commission. The Commission disbursed \$81.60 of this amount to defendant and \$151.50 to complainant. Defendant also credited complainant's account in the amount of \$151.50. However, the dispute was not settled at that time.

In order to settle the pending complaint, defendant will further credit complainant's account in the amount of \$163.20 to eliminate the \$81.60 charge and to refund the \$81.60 paid to it.

Complainant having filed a written request for dismissal without prejudice and defendant stipulating to such dismissal,


