ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this filing complainant requests modification of the tariffs of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific) to allow general or electrical contractors to install residence interior telephone wiring in accordance with Pacific's specifications. At the time of filing, Pacific's Tariff 36T, Rule 16, required the defendant to install all residence interior wiring. The matter was set for hearing on April 28, 1980. It was subsequently removed from the Commission Daily Calendar, pending negotiations between the parties.

On December 30, 1980 the Commission approved Resolution No. T-10346. This resolution, effective January 8, 1981 establishes a new tariff schedule covering customer-provided residence interior wiring in certain types of residential units when such units are under construction. This resolution effectively grants the relief sought in Case No. 10833 and renders the complaint moot.

Finding of Fact

Resolution No. T-10346 establishes a new tariff schedule covering customer-provided residence interior wiring.

Conclusion of Law

Resolution No. T-10346 renders Case No. 10833 moot.

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10833 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
