INTERIM ORDER

In this complaint, Affiliated Cab Drivers (complainants) allege that K.T.L. Co. Limousine, Allied Limousines, and V.S.P. Limousines (defendants) are in violation of Commission General Order No. 98-A and ask for a cease and desist order from such activities. Also named in the caption of the complaint were Hilton Hotels Corporation (Beverly Hilton), and the city of Beverly Hills and its Director of Transportation, John Logan.

Because Hilton Hotels Corporation, the city of Beverly Hills, and John Logan are neither public utilities nor other regulated businesses over which this Commission has jurisdiction, the complaint as to these defendants should be dismissed.
