O P I N I O N

Applicant Charles May Trotter requests the issuance of a dump truck carrier permit. At the time of filing this application, applicant held a highway common carrier certificate issued pursuant to Section 1063.5 of the Public Utilities Code under File T-72454, in Application GC No. 645, and a Highway Contract Carrier permit issued pursuant to Section 3572.5 of the Public Utilities Code. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of December 16, 1980. No protest to the application has been received.

Applicant's place of business is at 4456 Northridge Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90043. Applicant operates one dump truck and proposes to haul sand, gravel, concrete and broken asphalt in Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura Counties. As of December 1, 1980, applicant's balance sheet indicates a net worth of \$92,524. The application is supported by J&R Trucking, 3105 E. South Street, Long Beach, CA 90805 (Cal T-117468) and B&P Construction Company, 8737 Venice Blvd., Los Angeles, CA 90034.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant is a fit and proper person to receive a permit as a dump truck carrier and possesses sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to perform the proposed operation.

2. Applicant's equipment will not endanger the safety of the highways nor impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.

3. Applicant's proposed operation will not unnecessarily burden the public highways, is necessary to serve the public, and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

4. Applicant has resided in the State of California for not less than ninety days immediately preceding the filing of this application.

5. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

6. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be issued a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between all points in Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura Counties.

2. The effective date of the order should be the date of issuance to be consistent with the issuance of permit to other classes of carriers.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that upon applicant's compliance with the Commission's General Order 100 Series, the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Charles May Trotter, doing business as Trotter & Son, authorizing operations within and between all points in Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura Counties.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
