O P I N I O N

Applicants Joseph M. Price, Jr. and Joan L. Price request the issuance of a dump truck carrier permit. At the time of filing this application, applicants held no other operating authority from this Commission. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of January 15, 1981. No protest to the application has been received.

Applicants' place of business is at #6 Silver Fir Drive, Truckee. Applicants operate one end dump truck and propose to haul aggregates and asphaltic concrete. As of December 31, 1980 applicants' balance sheet indicated a net worth of \$118,500. The application is supported by a statement from A. Teichert & Son, Inc., a shipper domiciled in Donner Lake. Joseph M. Price, Jr. has been a heavy construction equipment operator for over a year.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicants are fit and proper persons to receive a permit as a dump truck carrier and possess sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to perform the proposed operation.

2. Applicants' equipment will not endanger the safety of highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.

3. Applicants' proposed operation will not unnecessarily burden the public highways, is necessary to serve the public, and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

4. Applicants have resided in the State of California for not less than ninety days immediately preceding the filing of this application.

5. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

6. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

Conclusion of Law

Applicants should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between all points in the counties of Placer, El Dorado, Nevada, and Sierra. The effective date of the following order should be the date of signature to be consistent with the issuance of permits to other classes of carriers.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that upon applicants' compliance with the Commission's General Order No. 100-Series, the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Joseph M. Price, Jr. and Joan L. Price authorizing operations within and between all points in the counties of Placer, El Dorado, Nevada, and Sierra.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
