OPINION AND ORDER AMENDING DECISION 92567

It has come to the Commission's attention that Decision 92567 does not reflect the intent of said decision with regard to the discussion in the second and third paragraphs.

The second and third paragraphs inadvertently stated that Austin L. Mount, Supervisor, Cal-United Operation, United Van Lines requested the extension of the provisions of Item 33.7 to December 31, 1981. The discussion should have stated that:

"The Transportation Division staff is currently conducting studies in connection with the Commission's reregulation program of Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B, Case No. 5330, Order Setting Hearing 100. The staff recommends that the expiration date in Item 33.7 be extended for an additional year to December 31, 1981."

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Paragraphs two and three of Decision 92567 dated December 30, 1980 are deleted and in their place insert:

"The Transportation Division staff is currently conducting studies in connection with the Commission's reregulation program of Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B, Case No. 5330, Order Setting Hearing 100. The staff recommends that the expiration date in Item 33.7 be extended for an additional year to December 31, 1981."

2. In all other respects Decision 92567, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

3. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this order on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B.
