ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR
RECONSIDERATION OF DECISION NO. 89355

On October 5, 1978 California Manufacturers Association (CMA) filed a Petition for Reconsideration of Decision No. 89355. That decision revised the minimum rates for general commodities in Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2, 9-B, 15, and 19.

Subsequently, the Commission canceled those minimum rate tariffs as part of its reregulation plan adopted in Decision No. 90663. Therefore, CMA's petition is moot and should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Reconsideration of Decision No. 89355 filed by California Manufacturers Association on October 5, 1978 in the captioned proceedings is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
