OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, John T. Reed, Consultant, for and on behalf of Tommy L. Appleton, doing business as APP's Delivery Service (APP's), requests authority to publish an expedited service rule.

APP's states that the new rule will apply only to expedited same-day service when requested by the party paying the transportation charges and is a new service at a new charge.

APP's avers that in no event would the proposed publication increase its California intrastate gross revenue by as much as one percent.

Findings of Fact

1. The proposed charges are justified because they match costs with special expedited service.

2. The following order complies with the guidelines in the Commission's highway carrier Energy-Efficiency Plan.

3. A public hearing is not necessary.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. John T. Reed, Consultant, is hereby authorized to publish in Local Freight Tariff ICC PCT 300-A, Cal. P.U.C. No. 5, on behalf of Tommy L. Appleton, the amendments specifically proposed in the application.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The authority granted herein shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof.
