ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision No. 89299 dated August 22, 1978, the Commission granted Jack Burtch Company, a corporation, permission to publish rates which were less than the Commission's established minimum rates for the transportation of residual fuel oil in tank truck equipment. The authority was granted on an interim basis and published for the carrier in Item 565 of Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, Local and Joint Freight and Express Tariff No. 18, Cal. P.U.C. No. 24. Item 565 was cancelled on January 5, 1979, by petitioner.
