ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

By Decision 93015 dated May 5, 1981 in the above applications Greyhound Lines, Inc. was granted authority to extend its passenger stage corporation authority to provide service in the Simi Valley area of southern California and also to extend its service to points on State Highway 154 between Goleta and Buellton including Solvang and Santa Ynez.

Ordering Paragraph 2(c) inadvertently required ten days' notice for tariff and timetable filings rather than the requested five days' notice.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 2(c) of Decision 53015 is amended to read:

(c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than 5 days after the effective date of this order on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the authorized service.
