ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company filed on January 15, 1981, tariff schedules which provide for the sale of equipment such as new style decorator telephones. The Commission's order in Case 10949 filed February 18, 1981, suspended these tariffs until May 22, 1981. It is necessary to extend the suspension of these tariffs; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation of each of the tariff sheets set forth in Advice Letter 13793 of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is extended for a further period of six months, as provided by statute, to November 22, 1981, unless otherwise ordered hereafter.
