
IT IS ORDERED that Appendix A of Decision 93031 be corrected

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS  
AND SPECIFICATIONS.

\*Glen Holden Esrig and Stephen B. Prine, by the Certificate

of Public Convenience and Necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin are authorized to transport rafters and their rafts for recreational purposes between points adjacent to the American River in Sacramento county, as hereinafter described, in section 2; over and along the routes hereinafter described, subject, however, to the authority of this commission to change or modify said routes at any time and subject to the following provisions.

- (a) Motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at the intersections of roads or by operating around an area contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- (b) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- (c) Service shall be operated Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, during the seasonal period, May, September and October of each year.
- (d) Service shall be operated daily during the months of June, July and August.
- (e) Applicant shall not pickup or discharge passengers except at the specified service point or points hereinafter set-forth.
