OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant Gordon Perkins Morris requests the issuance of a dump truck carrier permit. At the time of filing this application, applicant held a highway contract carrier permit. Notice of the filing of this application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 25, 1981. No protest to the application has been received.

Applicant's place of business is at 9422 Marella Drive Lakeside, CA 92040. Applicant operates one end dump semitrailer unit and proposes to haul dirt, sand, rock, gravel and demolition material within and between all points in Imperial, Orange, Riverside and San Diego Counties. As of February 2, 1981, applicant's balance sheet indicates a net worth of \$132,618. The application is supported by an overlying carrier and a shipper.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant is a fit and proper person to receive a permit as a dump truck carrier and possesses sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to conduct the proposed operation.

2. Applicant's equipment will not endanger the safety of the highways nor impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.

3. Applicant's proposed operation will not unnecessarily burden the public highways, is necessary to serve the public, and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

4. Applicant has resided in the State of California for not less than ninety days immediately preceding the filing of this application.

5. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

6. The following order complies with the guidelines in the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be issued a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between all points in Imperial, Orange, Riverside and San Diego Counties.

2. The effective date of the order should be the date of issuance to be consistent with the issuance of permits to other classes of carriers.

IT IS ORDERED that upon applicant's compliance with the Commission's General Order 100-Series, the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Gordon Perkins Morris, doing business as Morris Equipment Rental, authorizing operations within and between all points in Imperial, Orange, Riverside and San Diego Counties.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
