ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision (D.) 84763 dated August 5, 1975, applicant was authorized as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-972) to conduct a multi-day sightseeing service to the wine country from San Francisco.

Ordering Paragraph 2 of the decision required applicant to comply with the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Orders Series 101 and file tariffs and timetables. Applicant has not filed tariffs or timetables. By letter dated April 8, 1981 the Transportation Division staff requested applicant to inform it of what applicant's intentions were in this matter. By letter dated April 13, 1981 applicant informed the staff that it had never commenced operations, does not intend to do so in the future, and has no objection to revocation of the authority.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked.


