ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION

Rate Reduction 302 (RR-302) involves transportation by Walker Freight Lines of packages (parcels) within the San Diego Metropolitan area. By letter of April 21, 1981 the Executive Director, under authority of Resolution M-4713, suspended the rates in RR-302 before the rates went into effect for a period of 45 days, in response to the protest filed by Pacific Messenger Service, Inc., in (I&S) Case 10977.

Walker Freight Lines has not submitted the additional operational data required to evaluate the proposed rate reductions. Therefore, RR-302 should be suspended for a further period beyond June 5, 1981, the current expiration date.

IT IS ORDERED that the tariff provisions contained in RR-302 of Walker Freight Lines which were suspended April 21, 1981 are further suspended and the use of RR-302 is deferred until further order of the Commission.

This order is effective today.
