ORDER OF REVOCATION

By the Commission's Decision (D.) 91207 dated January 8, 1980 in Application (A.) 59043 Mark B. Anderson (Anderson), a sole proprietor, doing business as Adventure Tours, Ltd., was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity, (PSC-1098) under Section 1031, et seq., of the Public Utilities Code, to operate as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers and their attendant baggage between the Fashion Valley Shopping Center located in the City of San Diego, on the one hand, and that area commonly known as the Snow Summit Ski Resort in the vicinity of Big Bear Lake located in San Bernardino County, on the other hand.

On September 9, 1980 Anderson filed A.59976 requesting exemption from Ordering Paragraph 2(a) of D.91207 in A.59043 requiring that Anderson comply with the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order 101-C.

By the Commission's D.92675 dated February 4, 1981 in A.59976 Anderson's request for exemption from the provisions of the Commission's General Order 101-C was denied.

On March 3, 1981 Kathryn E. Muir, attorney at law, wrote the Commission that Anderson, as her client, indicated that he was financially unable to conduct the service and that he requests that the Commission close its files in the matter of the operative rights granted him to act as a passenger stage corporation.

The Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the certificate.

The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service should be canceled. The order below should be effective immediately because the required public liability and property damage insurance certificate has not been filed with the Commission.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity (PSC-1098) granted to Mark B. Anderson, a sole proprietor, doing business as Adventure Tours, Ltd., authorizing operations as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers and their attendant baggage between the Fashion Valley Shopping Center located in the City of San Diego, on the one hand, and that area commonly known as the Snow Summit Ski Resort in the vicinity of Big Bear Lake located in San Bernardino County, on the other hand, is revoked. All effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Mark B. Anderson, a sole proprietor, doing business as Adventure Tours, Ltd., are canceled upon the effective date of this order.
