O P I N I O N

Applicant Gary Thomas Burch, an individual doing business as Burch Trucking, requests the issuance of a dump truck carrier permit. Applicant presently holds no authority issued by this Commission. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of March 13, 1981. No protests to the application have been received.

Applicant's principal place of business is located at 6164 Granby Avenue, Alta Loma, CA 91701, and his equipment is kept and maintained there.

Applicant proposes to operate as a subhauler in Los Angeles, San Bernardino, and Orange Counties. He is familiar with the rates in Minimum Rate Tariffs 17 and 20. As of March 1, 1981 applicant indicates a net worth of \$75,325.

As an attachment to his application, applicant has filed a letter from a dump truck carrier indicating that it would use the services of the applicant in the counties applied for as a subhauler.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant has demonstrated a that:
  - a. He is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
  - b. He has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.
  - c. The privilege sought:
    - (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.
    - (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
    - (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.
2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for not less than 90 days preceding the filing of this application.
3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

4. The following order should be effective the date of the signature consistent with the issuance of permits to other classes of carriers.

5. The following order complies with the guidelines in the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

Conclusion of Law

Applicant should be granted a dump truck permit authorizing operations within and between all points in the Counties of Los Angeles, San Bernardino, and Orange.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Gary Thomas Burch, an individual doing business as Burch Trucking, authorizing operations within and between the Counties of Los Angeles, San Bernardino, and Orange.

This order is effective today.
