ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 92914. TERMINATING THE STAY AND DENYING REHEARING

A petition for rehearing and stay of Decision No. 92914 has been filed by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific). A petition for modification of that decision has been filed by David Wilner on behalf of Consumers Lobby Against Monopolies (Wilner).

On May 5, 1981, by Decision No. 93032 we granted a stay of Decision No. 92914 which was then extended by Decision No. 93097, issued on May 19, 1981.

By Decision 93251, issued and effective today, we have issued the final opinion in this proceeding and have thereby rendered most the issues raised by Pacific and Wilner in their petitions. Therefore, we are of the opinion that rehearing of Decision No. 92914 should be denied, the stay thereof should be terminated and it should be made clear that erdering paragraphs 1 and 2 of that decision are superseded by the order in Decision 93251. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) The stay of Decision No. 92914 is hereby terminated.
- (2) Ordering paragraphs 1 and 2 of Decision No. 92914 are superseded by the order in Decision No. 93251.
- (3) Except as herein provided, rehearing and modification of Decision No. 92914 are hereby denied.

This order is effective today.
