ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 92864
AND DENYING REHEARING

Petitions for rehearing of Decision No. 92864 have been filed by Neill Smith and Radio Station KCBS-AM. The Commission has considered each and every allegation contained in the petitions and is of the opinion that good cause for granting rehearing has not been shown. However, the petition of KCBS-AM has raised an area of ambiguity which we will correct through the modification set forth below.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 92864 is modified as follows:

Finding of Fact No. 23 is modified to read:

"In approving the transmission line as proposed, the mitigation measures of placing mica blocks under tower footings and detuning of towers in critical areas are adopted, as well as any other necessary and feasible mitigation measures to eliminate interference affecting KCBS' ability to operate in conformity with the requirements of its then current FCC license. The costs associated with these measures will be included in the overall project cost."

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 92864 as modified herein is hereby denied.
