O P I N I O N

Walter Hoffman requests that he be issued a permit to operate as a charter-party carrier of passengers under Public Utilities (PU) Code § 5384(b).

Applicant proposes to operate a 1969 Cadillac, 7-passenger limousine. As of March 16, 1981, applicant indicated a net worth of \$10,370.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of April 21, 1981. No protest has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant has the ability, experience, equipment, and financial resources to perform the proposed service.
2. Applicant's business address is 427 14th Avenue, San Francisco, CA 94118.
3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusion of Law

The application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. A charter-party carrier of passengers permit as defined in PU Code § 5384(b) is authorized to be issued to Walter Hoffman.

2. The Passenger Operations Branch will issue the annual renewable permit on Form PE-693 as authorized by Resolution PE-303, when it receives California Highway Patrol clearances and evidence of liability protection in compliance with General Order Series 115.


3. In providing service under the permit, applicant shall comply with General Order Series 98 and 115, and the California Highway Patrol safety rules.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
