ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Ordering Paragraph 9 of Decision (D.) 92549 directs
Southern California Edison Company (Edison) to submit to the Commission
by June 30, 1981, a report on its revised cost-effectiveness
guidelines for conservation.

By letter dated June 26, 1981, Edison requests an extension of the deadline date to July 31, 1981. Edison states that it requires the additional time to analyze recent Commission decisions relating to cost-effectiveness and to discuss its methodology with the Commission staff (staff). Staff does not object to granting the extension of time.

We find that the requested extension of time is necessary for Edison to comply properly with Ordering Paragraph 9. A public hearing would serve no useful purpose.

We conclude that the requested extension of time should be granted. The necessary modification of D.92549 should be made effective today.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 9 of D.92549 be modified to read as follows:

Edison shall expand its cost-effectiveness guidelines, for conservation, to include the full marginal cost of electricity and submit a report on the guidelines to the Commission by July 31, 1981.

This order is effective today.
