ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR MODIFICATION OF DECISION 93037

Tehachapi Mountain Water Service (Tehachapi) on June 16, 1981, filed a petition seeking modification of Decision (D.) 93037, issued May 19, 1981.

Apparently Tehachapi seeks modification of Ordering Paragraph 1 of D.93037, which denied a request to extend compliance with Ordering Paragraph 2 of D.91122 issued December 18, 1979. This order required Tehachapi to increase its water supply to a minimum of 250 gpm by July 31, 1981. In addition, it appears that Tehachapi seeks extension of time for compliance with Ordering Paragraph 6 of D.93037, which required a reduction in rates to be made effective September 1, 1981, if the supply increase ordered by July 31, 1981, is not achieved.

We find that Tehachapi's petition cites no facts or arguments that were not considered by the Commission when it recently issued D.93037, or which are relevant to the petition before us.

We conclude that the petition for modification of D.93037 should be denied.

A public hearing in this matter is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The petition of Tehachapi Mountain Water Service (Tehachapi) for modification of D.93037 is denied.

2. Tehachapi shall deliver or mail a copy of this decision to each of its customers within 30 days of the date of its issuance.

3. The order in D.93037 remains in full force and effect.

This order is effective today.
