ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Ordering Paragraph 19 of Decision (D.) 92549 directs Southern California Edison Company (Edison) to file with the Commission by June 30, 1981, revised streetlighting schedules for its tariffs.

By letter dated June 26, 1981, Edison requests an extension of the deadline date to July 31, 1981. Edison states that it requires the additional time to prepare the tariff filing. The Commission staff does not object to granting the extension of time.

We find that the requested extension of time is necessary for Edison to comply properly with Ordering Paragraph 19. A public hearing would serve no useful purpose.

We conclude that the requested extension of time should be granted. The necessary modification of D.92549 should be made effective today.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 19 of D.92549 be modified to read as follows:

By July 31, 1981, Edison shall file revised streetlighting schedules, restructuring them in a manner that will simplify them and improve their comprehensibility.

This order is effective today.
