ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 92791 AND DENYING REHEARING

Petitions for modification and rehearing of Decision No. 92791 have been filed by Holocard and responses thereto have been filed by General Telephone Company of California and Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company. We have carefully considered each and every allegation of error in Holocard's petitions and are of the opinion that good cause for granting rehearing has not been shown. However, Decision No. 92791 should be modified to clarify our conclusion with respect to the antitrust or anticompetitive allegations of Holocard. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Conclusion of Law No. 4 in Decision No. 92791 is deleted, to be replaced by the following:

"4. Nothing in the instant decision bars Complainant Holocard from entering the existing credit verification field on the same terms as others." Rehearing of Decision No. 92791, as modified herein, is denied.
