ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company filed on March 6, 1981, tariff revisions to establish a new tariff schedule covering the Variable Term Payment Plan. The Commission's order in Case 10978 filed April 21, 1981, suspended these tariffs until August 17, 1981. It is necessary to extend the suspension of these tariffs; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation of each of the tariff sheets set forth in Advice Letter 13857 of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is extended for a further period of six months, as provided by statute, to February 17, 1982, unless otherwise ordered hereafter.
