O P I N I O N

A. A. Addison and L. A. Addison (applicants), doing
business as A. A. ^{and} L.A. Addison & Co., a copartnership,
seek a dump truck carrier permit. They propose to transport dirt
within and between all points in the Counties of Los Angeles,
Orange, and Ventura. Applicants' principal place of business is
at 17907 Mackeson Court, Carson, California 90746. Applicants
presently hold a highway contract carrier permit issued by this
Commission under File T-131,772.

Applicants own and propose to operate one end dump truck
in the proposed operation. Their balance sheet shows a net worth
of \$72,000 as of April 22, 1981. Applicants have filed letters of
support from a shipper and a prime carrier.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the
Commission's Daily Calendar of May 7, 1981. No protests have been
received.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicants are fit and proper persons to receive a dump truck carrier permit.
2. Applicants have sufficient knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.
3. Applicants' service
 - a. Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the use of the highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.
 - b. Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
 - c. Is necessary to serve the public.
 - d. Will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.
4. One of the equal partners has resided in the State of California for not less than 90 days next preceding the filing of the application.
5. A public hearing is not necessary.
6. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
7. The following order complies with the guidelines in the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.
8. The following order should be effective on the date it is signed to be consistent with other highway permit authorizations.

Conclusion of Law


Applicants should be granted a dump truck carrier permit to operate within and between all points in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, and Ventura.


O R D E R


