# Decision 93450 AUG 181981

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the application of Jerry Brent Curttright doing business as Curttright Trucking, for a dump truck carrier permit (File 372.70)

## <u>o p i n i o n</u>

Jerry Brent Curttright (applicant), an individual doing business as Curttright Trucking, seeks a dump truck carrier permit. He proposes to transport dirt, rock, broken asphalt, concrete, and trash within and between all points in the County of Los Angeles. Applicant's principal place of business is at 12713 Marco Place, Los Angeles, CA 90066. Applicant presently holds a highway contract carrier permit issued by this Commission under File T-125,600.

Applicant owns and proposes to operate a Kenworth enddump truck in the proposed operation. His balance sheet shows a net worth of \$68,700 as of April 27, 1981. Applicant has attached to his application letters of support from a shipper and an overlying carrier.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of May 14, 1981 and copies of the application were furnished to a number of different carrier and shipper associations. No protests have been received.

#### Findings of Fact

1. Applicant is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.

2. Applicant has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.

- 3. Applicant's service
  - a. Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the use of the highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them either directly or indirectly.
  - b. Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
  - c. Is necessary to serve the public.
  - d. Will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

4. The applicant has resided in the State of California for not less than 90 days next preceding the filing of the application.

5. A public hearing is not necessary.

6. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

7. The following order complies with the guidelines in the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

8. The following order should be effective on the date it is signed to be consistent with other highway permit authorizations.

### Conclusion of Law

Applicant should be granted a dump truck permit to operate within and between all points in the County of Los Angeles.

## $\underline{O \ \underline{R} \ \underline{D} \ \underline{E} \ \underline{R}}$

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue to Jerry Brent Curttright, an individual doing business as Curttright Trucking, a dump truck carrier permit to operate between all points in the County of Los Angeles when applicant has complied with General Order Series 100.
