## ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AND DISMISSING ACTION

On August 14, 1981, California Community Television Association, Inc. (CCTA) and Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) filed a joint motion for an order approving a settlement of this case and dismissing it. They attached to their motion a copy of their Agreement Settling Disputes and Releasing Claims, containing the terms and conditions for resolving this case as well as other litigation pending between CCTA, PG&E, CCTA's member cable television systems, and certain individuals.

We conclude that the motion should be granted and that the following order should be effective today so that the terms and conditions of the agreement may be put into operation as soon as possible.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- l. The resolution of the disputes in this case between California Community Television Association, Inc. and Pacific Gas and Electric Company by the terms and conditions of their Agreement Settling Disputes and Releasing Claims is approved; and,
  - 2. Case 10651 is dismissed.

This order is effective today.
