ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By its complaint in Case (C.) 10912, Public Services
Planning and Analysis Corporation (PSPAC) alleges violations by
Airport Limousine Service of Sunnyvale, Inc. (ALSS) of (1) defendant's
passenger stage corporation certificate which authorizes service
from and to major San Francisco Bay Area airports and (2) certain
provisions of the Public Utilities Code. By Application (A.) 59969,
ALSS seeks authority to make certain revisions in its passenger
tariff which were protested by PSPAC.

The two matters were consolidated for public hearing which was held before Administrative Law Judge Arthur M. Mooney in San Francisco on January 26, 1981. The proceeding was submitted on briefs due March 9, 1981. Prior to the submission date, the parties advised that Airport Connection Corporation (ACC), PSPAC's parent company, was acquiring ALSS and that upon approval of the acquisition by the Commission, ACC would request that the two matters be dismissed. The acquisition was approved by Decision 93207 dated June 16, 1981 in A.60383. By letter dated July 8, 1981, ACC requested that C.10912 and A.59969 be dismissed.

We find that the requested dismissal is reasonable and conclude that it should be granted. In the circumstances,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. C.10912 is dismissed.
2. A.59969 is dismissed.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
