ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR COMPLIANCE WITH ORDERING PARAGRAPH 3 OF DECISION 93251

In Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision 93251, Pacific Telephone and Telegraph (Pacific), defendant in the above-captioned proceedings, was ordered to establish on or before October 1, 1981, the "Advocates Trust Fund of the California Public Utilities Commission," as that fund is described in that decision. The fund was to be established at a financial institution to be named by the Executive Director. Pacific was to be reimbursed for reasonable legal fees, up to a limit of \$2,000, for its legal and administrative costs in establishing the charitable trust vehicle for the Advocates Trust Fund.

Since Decision 93251 was announced on June 30, 1981, our staff has been investigating different possibilities for establishing the charitable trust and for managing the assets to be placed in the trust. Essentially those possibilities are being considered in order to minimize costs for establishing the trust and to avoid the substantial trustees fees which would be charged by a financial institution for managing the trust assets.



No final determination has been made whether Pacific or private legal counsel should establish the charitable trust, or whether the trust should be managed by a financial institution or a bonded individual (e.g., an investment counselor) whose fees would be lower.

In the circumstances, Pacific must be excused from compliance with the October 1, 1981, deadline, which shall already have passed by the time of this order. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

The time for compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision 93251 is extended until such time as is specified in further order of the Commission.
